An updated, colorful and trendy version of grandma's jewelry tray!

Supplies:

- 1 - "Perfect" Best Paper (8" x 10")
- 1 - "Simply Lovely" Damask paper (2 3/8" x 10")
- 1 - "One of a Kind" Notable paper (1 3/4" x 10" hand cut)
- 1 - "Simply Lovely" Doily paper (hand cut doilies)
- 1 - "Perfect" Flawless paper (top layer of initials)
- 1 - "Happiness" Peppy paper (bottom layer of initials)
- 1 - "Love" Title

Also used: 4 drawer pulls, "Suzy" open frame (from Hobby Lobby) or any frame of your choosing, 8 x 10 clear glass, cardboard, ink pad, adhesive, black thread, sewing machine and hot glue gun.

Instructions:

1. Cut papers to size as listed above.
2. Hand cut pink chevron design (zig zag) and adhere to center of yellow polka dot strip. If you are going to sew along edges, keep adhesive in center.
3. Adhere to background piece as shown and sew along edges, if desired.
4. Hand cut three "doilies" from doily paper.
5. Layer doilies with title as shown.
6. Add monogram and put in frame. (Make sure back is secure and won't pop off)
7. Hot glue on the drawer pulls or use wood glue if the pulls are wood.
8. ENJOY!

You could add dimensional products to the top of the frame if you want to really "jazz" it up!
