### *Spider Supplies:*

- 2 - "Hallows Music" paper
- 1 - "Hallows Pumpkin" paper
- 1 - "Hallows Dots" paper

### *Apothecary Bottles:*

- 1 - 12 x 12 Glittered Accessories Sheet
- 1 - 12 x 12 Chipboard Accessories

### *Framed papers:*

- 1 - "Hallows Skull Doily" paper
- 1 - "Hallows Pattern" paper
- 1 - "Hallows Newsprint" paper

**Don't forget: Layered stickers, decorative brads and stamps!**

Also used: double stick tape or tape runner, hot glue gun, assorted bottles (I raided/cleaned out my refrigerator), assorted frames, water bottle and pencil, beans, sugar cubes, water, etc. to fill the jars.

### *Instructions:*

#### 1. Spider:

- Print patterns, trace and cut on pumpkin (head) and dots (body) papers. Cut out.
- Fold as shown and adhere together.
- Cut (16) 3 x 6 pieces of Hallows Music paper.
- Spritz with water and roll around pencil. When dry, continue rolling until in the shape of a cone and adhere together.
- Using hot glue, adhere two cones together to form the spider legs.
- Adhere legs and body together using hot glue.



## 2. Apothecary Bottles:

- Punch out desired chipboard and accessories pieces. Add to bottles (use double stick tape for die cut pieces).
- Fill bottles as desired.

## 3. Frames:

- Spray frames black, if desired.
- Cut papers to size. Add embellishments, if desired.
