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## "How to be a ..." layout

Featuring: The Spider's Web collection

### Supplies:

- 1 - 12 x 12 The Spider's Web Cauldron Bubbles paper
- 1 - 3 x 12 The Spider's Web Spider's Silk paper
- 1 - 4 x 12 The Spider's Web Haunted Parlor paper
- 1 - 6 x 8 The Spider's Web Scaredy Cats paper
- 1 - 2 ½ x 18 and 1 x 12 (vertical stripes)  
The Spider's Web Toil and Trouble paper
- 1 - 4 ¾ x 6 ¾ The Spider's Web Witch's Lace paper
- 1 - The Spider's Web Accessory Sheet
- 1 package Laundry Line Lucky Trim
- 1 package Orange Glittered Chipboard

Also used: Black ink, black pen (journaling),  
Glitz alphabet stickers, pop dots

### Instructions:

- Step 1: Cut paper to sizes given above. Ink all edges, if desired.
- Step 2: Adhere 3 x 12 strip of Spider's Silk paper along the right edge of Cauldron Bubbles paper.
- Step 3: Adhere Scaredy Cats paper (back side up) about 2" from top of layout.
- Step 4: Trim around damask strip of Haunted Parlor paper and adhere over seam.
- Step 5: Punch out Witch's Lace scallop strip from Accessory Sheet. Ink edges, curl up scallops and adhere to just under photo mat with adhesives on the top only, so you can still slide paper under it.
- Step 6: Rip bottom of 2 ½ x 18 skull (Toil and Trouble) paper. Ink edges. Fold over and staple strip.
- Step 7: Glue green sequin ribbon to top of ruffled paper.
- Step 8: Adhere to paper just under scallops.
- Step 9: Add stripe paper under skull paper.
- Step 10: Add photos, chipboard and sticker title and tag.  
Tip: Have your child write on the tag.

Journaling: Write journaling on a tag and tuck 4 x 6 photo.
