Supplies:

- 1 sheet of 'How fortunate' – Good luck
- 1 sheet of 'Lucky Me' - Orange Crush
- 1 sheet of 'Sisters' - Orange Blossom diecut edges
- Just the Girls' – Title die Cut
- 'How Fortunante' die cut accents
- 'Lucky Me' Chipboard accents
- 'Hello World' journaling card

Other items: Foam Adhesive, Green Pen, Ink Pad.

Instructions:

- 1 Cut the Orange blossom Paper to size.
I wanted to keep the outer die cut edge but for it to be a smaller square so I cut strips out of the middle of the sheet and then pieced the pattern back together by eye to make it match up as close as possible.
2. Adhere the Orange Blossom paper to the Orange Crush sheet close the the edge and then hand cut a smaller border. (this helps lift the Orange Blossom sheet out of the Good luck paper.)
3. Ink all your die cut & chipboard peices.
4. Matt your photos on the remaining Orange Crush.
5. Arrange the peices as you want and select some to be foam mounted to give depth to the layout.
6. Add your Journaling.
7. Outline your pieces with your pen for a whimsical touch.



This is a very simple layout but it focuses everything on that one detail in your photograph that means the most.
